Public Hearing

HB 2830

Requires contractor of new residential structure or zero-lot-line dwelling to provide property owner or original purchaser warranty for building envelope and penetration components.

HB 2006

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Extends personal injury protection benefit coverage for certain expenses from one year after date of injury to two years after date of injury.

HB 2821

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies amount of reimbursement due personal injury protection provider when total benefits exceed damages.

HB 2824

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Clarifies that tow operator does not need to contact owner of parking facility or owner's agent at time of tow before towing motor vehicle from facility if sign warning that parking is prohibited is posted or if motor vehicle is parked next to red or yellow curb.

HB 2848

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that expenses for medical, hospital, dental, surgical, ambulance and prosthetic services that insurer must pay under personal injury protection insurance policy are presumed to be reasonable and necessary if billed to insurer within 60 days after services are provided, unless service provider is given notice of denial of charges within 60 days after insurer receives notice of claim.

HB 2932

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits insurer from denying insured's claim under motor vehicle insurance policy if insurer learns that motor vehicle was previously declared total loss.

HB 3159

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Oregon Transportation Commission to set maximum rates for towing and related services when tow operator tows motor vehicle without consent or authorization of owner or operator.

Modifies laws relating to transfers of structured settlement payment rights.

Increases amount of money and goods that person may find without giving notice to county clerk.
