#### **Public Hearing**

HB 3016

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Exempts entire value of homestead from sale on execution, lien of judgment or liabilit for debts of owner if debt arises directly from or as result of "catastrophic or terminal illness or injury.

HB 3357

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Creates disclosure requirements related to use of refund anticipation payment instruments by tax consultants and tax preparers.

HB 3415

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires public body acting as radio common carrier to charge market rate for access to radio tower for delivery of radio communications service, radio paging or cellular communications service for him

HB 3447

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires person that conducts floral business operation to disclose physical location or person's principal place of business in advertisements for floral business operation.

### **Work Session**

HB 2429

Requires that public bodies develop and implement policies for securely removing personal information from digita data storage devices and other electronic data storage devices before selling, donating, recycling or otherwise disposing of device.

HB 2823

Specifies individuals who may control association accounts of planned community or condominium.

HB 2978

Sets out uniform provisions for certain aspects of state building code administration and enforcement.

HB 3166

Authorizes registered environmental health technicians to provide technical support and assistance to environmental health specialists, environmental health specialist trainees, waste water specialists and waste water specialist trainee

HB 3167 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that certain local units of government may contract with private entities to assist local units of government carrying out certain duties related to sewage.

HB 3258 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes office of State Chief Information Officer for purpose of directing policy and coordinating state government and state agencies in planning for, acquiring, installing and using telecommunications and information technology.

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on State Agency Information Technology Expertise for purpose of investigating extent to which creating division or other administrative unit within state agency and employing information technology specialists to meet common and critical information technology needs among state agencies is practical and feasible and to determine costs and benefits of employing information technology specialists within state agencies compared costs and benefits of contracting for
