- HB 2927 \*\*  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes Task Force on State Government Boards and Commissions. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

- HB 3357  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Creates disclosure requirements related to use of refund anticipation payment instruments by tax consultants and tax preparers.
- HB 3411  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Expands circumstances under which breach of security requires notification under Oregon Consumer Identity Theft Protection Act to include disclosure of written data that contains personal information.
- HB 3415  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires public body acting as radio common carrier to charge market rate for access to radio tower for delivery of radio communications service, radio paging or cellular communications service for hii

- HB 3070  
Requires disclosure of shipping and handling charges in sale or advertisement of consumer good.
- HB 3144 \*\*  
Revises language regarding assumption of administration and enforcement of manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or partial building inspection program after municipality ceases administration and enforcement. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3168  
Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules for purposes of establishing statewide criteri by which certain qualified entities and authorized agencies conduct criminal records checks for purposes other than criminal justice.

- HB 3172  
Requires seller of real property to obtain septic system evaluation report and provide copies to Department of Environmental Quality and to each buyer that makes written offer to purchase.
- HB 3330 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires use of electronic fingerprint capture technology for purposes of conducting criminal records checks not related to administration of criminal justice system.
- HB 3331 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of State Police to establish Voluntary Central Criminal Records Check Registry.
