HB 3493

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Exempts from disclosure voter registration records of individuals less than 18 years of age as of date of request for disclosure.

SB 351 A

Allows tribal governments to invest in local government investment pool.

SB 406 A

Expands options for name after marriage or after entering into registered domestic partnership.

SB 631

Makes laws regulating restaurants and bed and breakfast facilities applicable to public bodies and to public corporations exempted from definition of public body.
