CARRIED OVER FROM THE 05/21/2013 AGENDA: Directs state agencies to participate as project or program team members to address regional priorities identified by Regional Advisory Committees as part of Oregon Solution Network.

- SB 525 A
 - Prohibits district attorney from allowing debt collection entity to use name, seal or letterhead of district attorney.
- SB 254 A
 - Specifies conditions under which contracting agency may use alternative contracting method to award public improvement contract for construction manager/general contractor services.
- SB 577 A
 - Adds specifications for service contracts and vehicle protection products that are subject to regulation.
- SB 617 A
 - Requires Appraiser Certification and Licensure Board to convene panel to determine whether objective basis exists believe that alleged violation of provisions governing real estate appraisers has occurred before disciplining person.
- SR 644
 - Permits contracting agency to directly appoint consultant to provide architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation planning or land surveying services if estimated value of services is less than \$100,000.
- SB 683 A
 - Prohibits health care practitioners from limiting referrals of patients to health care entities in which practitioner or practitioner's family member has financial interest or employment relationship.
