CARRIED OVER FROM 2/22/2013 AGENDA: Removes sunset on provisions related to use of restraint or seclusion on student in public education program.
- HB 2584  
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/22/2013 AGENDA: Removes sunset on legislation relating to restraint and seclusion of students in public education programs.
- HB 2756  
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/22/2013 AGENDA: Prohibits public education program from purchasing, building or otherwise taking possession of seclusion cell or from using seclusion cells.
- HB 2585  
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/22/2013 AGENDA: Directs State Board of Education to adopt process for complaints about incidents involving use of physical restraint or seclusion in public education programs.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2644  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs state education programs to submit specified information about number of students and number of licensed or registered teachers regularly assigned to students.
- HB 2664 \*\*  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation of use of standardized tests in public schools in this state. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2757  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs Department of Education to ensure that statewide assessment system, or alternative to statewide assessment system, is available for students whose primary language is American Sign Language.
