#### Work Session

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue HB 2424 \*\* Changes exclusion from local revenues for purposes of State School Fund distributions and local option equalization grants. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

HB 2994 \*\*

Creates tax credit for educational expenses paid for special needs student attending private school or public school charging tuition.

#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2729 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for purpose of United States Department of Agriculture's Afterschool Meal and Snack Program. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means HB 2730 \*\*

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Department of Education to reimburse school district, government agency or community group for every breakfast served during summer as part of summer meal program.

HB 3033

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows virtual public charter school or sponsor of virtual public charter school to contract with entity to provide educational services through virtual public charter school by persons who are not licensed or registered by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

HB 2747 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Requires district school board that admits nonresident students under contract or by giving consent to adopt specifie standards for admittance.

HB 2748

Prohibits district school board from charging tuition for nonresident students.
