- HB 2666 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Education to provide technical expertise to assist schools, school districts and education service districts in complying with standards adopted by State Board of Education pertaining to student education records.
- HB 2664 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation of use of standardized tests in public schools in this state.
- HB 2789  
Directs schools to provide drills and instruction on safety threats.
- HB 2640  
Adds one member to Oregon Education Investment Board as representative of oldest nonprofit network of parents in Oregon that provides statewide representation of parents.
- HB 2538  
Adds one member to Oregon Education Investment Board who serves as member of school district board.
