FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development, in cooperation with State Department of Energy, State Department of Agriculture and State Department of Fish and Wildlife, to review laws and rules regulating siting of solar energy projects in areas zoned for exclusive farm use and to make recommendations to legislative interim committees.

HB 2439

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Transfers certain duties, functions and powers related to renewable energy from State Department of Energy to Public Utility Commission.

HB 2274

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies, for purpose of gathering information related to greenhouse gas emissions, information that Environmental Quality Commission may require to be reported.
