HB 2820 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires State Department of Energy to study certain issues related to solar energy. HB 2795

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes community net metering for purpose of allowing subscribing customers to receive on-bill credit for portion of electricity produced by community net metering facility.

HB 2796

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows customer-generators to aggregate electricity generated by multiple net metering facilities if those net metering facilities are served by same electric utility.
