FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule provisions requiring that certain permit applications include analysis regarding toxic air emissions.

HB 2860

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Exempts diesel fuel sold for use in hospital facilities and long term care facilities from requirement to contain certain percentage of biodiesel or other diesel with specified percentage of renewable component.
