Public Hearing HB 2105 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Requires State Department of Energy to study issues related to Energy Facility Siting Council and to report to certain interim legislative committees on or before November 1, 2013. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use

HB 2106 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Requires Director of State Department of Energy, after consultation with other state agencies and parties, to develop map that identifies areas east of summit of Cascade Mountains that are appropriate for siting of energy facilities and any related or supporting facilities.

HB 2860

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/26/13 AGENDA. Exempts diesel fuel sold for use in hospital facilities and long term care facilities from requirement to contain certain percentage of biodiesel or other diesel with specified percentage of renewable component.

HB 2938

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Prohibits persons from knowingly disposing of rechargeable batteries as solid waste. HJM 7

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Urges Congress to increase investment in Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and Clean Water State Revolving Fund.
