#### Public Hearing

- HB 2437 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Allows credit against income taxes for purchase of energy efficient home.
- HB 2793 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue then to Ways and Means  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Requires Housing and Community Services Department to adopt by rule certain criteria for assignment of energy performance scores for residential buildings.
- HB 2801  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Authorizes public purpose charge moneys invested on cost-effective local energy conservation that involve updating energy efficiency of nonresidential building to be used for purpose of conducting whole building assessment of energy efficiency of building.
- HB 2817  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Provides that real estate appraisal activity includes issuance of opinion as to value associated with energy efficiency of buildings located on real property.
