CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/14/13 AGENDA
Repeals sunset on architectural paint stewardship program.
- HB 2813 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Agriculture and Natural Resources
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Declares plant commonly known as Giant Cane or Giant Reed to be noxious weed, plant pest and invasive species meriting eradication.
- HB 3251
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that person may not operate motor vehicle with gross vehicle weight rating greater than 200 pounds or specified all-terrain vehicles in beds or banks of certain waterways.
