Public Hearing

- HB 2894 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - For purposes of tax credits for energy conservation projects, increases amount of eligible cost for which credit may be claimed using informational filing system in place of certification and for which entire credit may be claimed in first allowable tax year.
- HB 3171
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Creates exemption from state preemption for local laws designed to prevent or control presence of pesticides in potable water.
- HB 3242 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that Director of Department of State Lands may adopt rules for authorization of certain renewable energy facilities or devices within Oregon's territorial sea.

Work Session

- HB 2106 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use
Requires Director of State Department of Energy, after consultation with other state agencies and parties, to develop map that identifies areas east of summit of Cascade Mountains that are appropriate for siting of energy facilities and any related or supporting facilities.
