Public Hearing

- HB 2981 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows exception to employment requirements for rural renewable energy development zone exemption from property taxation, and extension of exemption, if provided for in resolution of zc sponsor and business firm makes certain minimum investment in qualified property.
- HB 3451 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes Oceangoing Research Vessel Program to conduct certain marine research

Work Session

- HB 2894 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
For purposes of tax credits for energy conservation projects, increases amount of eligible cost for which credit may be claimed using informational filing system in place of certification and for which entire credit may be claimed in first allowable tax year.
- HB 2801
Authorizes public purpose charge moneys invested on cost-effective local energy conservation that involve updating energy efficiency of nonresidential building to be used for purpose of conducting whole building assessment of energy efficiency of building.
- HB 2893 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Public Utility Commission to establish program under which electric company must agree to purchase from retail electricity consumer electricity generated by solar photovoltaic energy system that is permanently installed by retail electricity consumer.
