Authorizes public purpose charge moneys invested on cost-effective local energy conservation that involve updating energy efficiency of nonresidential building to be used for purpose conducting whole building assessment of energy efficiency of building. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2893 **

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/2/13 AGENDA. Requires Public Utility Commission to establish program under which electric company must agree to purchase from retail electricity consumer electricity generated by solar photovoltaic energy system that is permanently installed by retail electricity consumer.

HB 2004

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Increases additional moneys to be collected from residential electricity consumers upon Housing and Community Services Department making certain findings related to need for low-income electric bill payment assistance.

HB 2005

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt amendments to state building code establishing mechanical insulation standards applicable to industrial buildings. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means HB 3030 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Department of Environmental Quality to establish grant and loan program for certain removal and remedial actions.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Urges Congress to enact legislation to modernize Toxic Substances Control Act.

HB 3451 **

Establishes Oceangoing Research Vessel Program to conduct certain marine research.
