CARRIED OVER FROM 4/2/13 AGENDA. Authorizes public purpose charge moneys invested on cost-effective local energy conservation that involve updating energy efficiency of nonresidential building to be used for purpose of conducting whole building assessment of energy efficiency of building.

HB 2893 **

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/2/13 AGENDA. Requires Public Utility Commission to establish program under which electric company must agree to purchase from retail electricity consumer electricity generated by solar photovoltaic energy system that is permanently installed by retail electricity consumer.
