FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Creates new definitions for provisions related to reduction of use of toxic substances and reduction of generation of hazardous waste.
- HB 2203  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Prohibits person from constructing electricity transmission line unless person is public utility or person that has entered into contract with public utility, and construction takes place in public utility service area.
- HB 2704 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs State Department of Energy to conduct study of issues related to siting and construction of electric transmission lines by certain entities.
