- HB 3492 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-16-13 AGENDA - Creates new definitions for provisions related to reduction of use of toxic substances and reduction of generation of hazardous waste.
- HB 2807 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-16-13 AGENDA - Requires State Department of Energy to study certain issues related to energy use.

Public Hearing

- HB 3011 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-16-13 AGENDA - Provides that state may not require certain persons to pay certain remedial action costs.
- HB 3186
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs Environmental Quality Commission to consider economic factors when adopting certain rules related to alternative sewage disposal systems.

- HB 3242 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use
Provides that Director of Department of State Lands may adopt rules for authorization of certain renewable energy facilities or devices within Oregon's territorial sea.
