Work Session

- SB 692 B
Establishes minimum energy efficiency standards for certain products.
- SB 605 A
Clarifies that Land Conservation and Development Commission must make findings on Territorial Sea Plan and amendments to Territorial Sea Plan or Oregon Ocean Resources Management Plan recommended by Ocean Policy Advisory Council.
- SB 606 A
Requires owners or operators of wave energy facilities and devices to demonstrate evidence of financial assurance for costs of closure and post-closure maintenance of facilities or devices.
- SB 230 A
Provides that order of Public Utility Commission on petition for proposed transmission line for which petitioner also seeks approval from Energy Facility Siting Council is subject to judicial review in same manner as order in contested case.
- SB 840 A
Imposes new water use limitations on fixtures.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 561 A
Modifies provision authorizing tariff schedules for use by public utilities that provide energy resource measures to individual property owners or customers.
