HB 2120

First Public Hearing: Provides that health professional regulatory boards have discretion to authorize licensees regulated by board to self-refer to impaired health professional program in which board participates.

HB 2124

First Public Hearing: Eliminates from impaired health professional program requirement that employers of program participants establish minimum training requirements for supervisors of participants.

HB 2130

First Public Hearing: Makes changes to impaired health professional program.
