FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Consolidates provisions relating to Oregon Health Licensing Agency's authority over certificates, permits, licenses and registrations and fees collected for certificates, permits, licenses and registrations. HB 2136 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs that moneys received under Master Settlement Agreement be distributed to Oregon Health Authority Fund and to Tobacco Use Reduction Account.

HB 2122

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits transfer of provider's enrollees from one managed care organization to another managed care organization with which provider contracts if provider's contract with transferring organizatic is terminated for cause.

HB 2181

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires insurer offering health insurance to have adequate network of trauma system hospitals in insurer's network of providers.
