HB 2691

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/22/2013 AGENDA: Authorizes nonresident physicians and nurses licensed and ir good standing in another state to provide volunteer services related to practice of medicine or nursing in this state under specified circumstances.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2896

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits entity doing business in this state as tanning facility from allowing person who is under 18 years of age to use tanning device that is owned or operated by entity.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes person licensed in practice of physical therapy in another jurisdiction to provide physical therapy services to individual in this state to whom person provided physical therapy services prior to providing services in this state.

HB 2684

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Changes circumstances under which licensed physical therapist must refer person to medical doctor, osteopathic physician, chiropractic physician, podiatric physician and surgeon, naturopathic physicia dentist, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.
