- HB 2896
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits entity doing business in this state as tanning facility from allowing person who is under 18 years of age to use tanning device that is owned or operated by entity.
- HB 2678
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes person licensed in practice of physical therapy in another jurisdiction to provide physical therapy services to individual in this state to whom person provided physical therapy services prior to providing services in this state.
- HB 2684
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Changes circumstances under which licensed physical therapist must refer person to medical doctor, osteopathic physician, chiropractic physician, podiatric physician and surgeon, naturopathic physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.
- HB 2104
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Revises definition of "medical imaging" to include medical imaging procedures not related to clinical diagnosis and treatment.
- HB 2093 **
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Makes changes to provisions of law related to vital statistics to reflect 2011 Revision to Model State Vital Statistics Act. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
