- HB 2969
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2013 AGENDA: Requires insurer that provides coverage of ambulance care and transportation to indemnify provider of ambulance care and transportation directly.
- HB 2132
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2013 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to take specified steps to enroll in qualified health plan person who loses eligibility for medical assistance.
- HB 2128
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2013 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to reach agreement on plans offered through exchange to educators.
- HB 2122
Prohibits transfer of provider's enrollees from one managed care organization to another managed care organization with which provider contracts if provider's contract with transferring organization is terminated for cause.
- HB 2714
Authorizes pharmacy to perform certain tests and examinations if pharmacy obtains waiver from United States Department of Health and Human Services and complies with applicable federal regulations.
- HB 2737 **
Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt standards and procedures to certify specified mental health providers to qualify for insurance reimbursement. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Repeals sunset on prohibition against dental services contract restricting price charged by provider for service not covered by contract.

HB 2947

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Repeals provision authorizing Oregon Health Authority to approve pilot projects under which dental health coordinators receive training and certification for purpose of educating communities on dental health.

HB 2948

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes dentists licensed in other countries to participate in educational activities related to dentistry that occur in this state.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Oregon Health Authority and Department of Human Services to adopt standards and conduct examinations to ensure linguistic competence of health care facility and residential facility direct care staff hired on or after January 1, 2014.
