#### Work Session

- HB 2090  
Repeals operative date provision to require Oregon Health Authority to continue to use Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan for prescription drug coverage in medical assistance program on and after January 2, 2014.
- HB 2137  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish system for repurposing durable medical equipment that is no longer medically appropriate for medical assistance recipients for use by other medical assistance recipients.
- HB 2076  
Requires covered entities to report annually on system safeguards for protecting confidentiality of individually identifiable health information.
- HCR 16  
Recognizes addiction as disease.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2928  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies definition of "hazardous substance." Requires Director of Oregon Health Authority to adopt standards for labeling of articles that contain hazardous substances.
- HB 3072  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires insurer to notify affected policyholders, and persons who requested notification, of rate filing for certain premium rate increases.
- HB 3466  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes pharmacist to initiate or modify drug therapy in accordance with guideline; and protocols established by physician licensed to practice medicine.
