#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 136 A

Provides that Oregon State Board of Nursing may authorize certified registered nurse anesthetists to prescribe prescription drugs under specified circumstances.

SB 169 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority, by February 1, 2015, to report to Legislative Assembly on prevalence of and costs related to prediabetes and diabetes in Oregon and on strategic plan to address prediabetes, diabetes and diabetes-related complications.

SB 413 A

Requires insurer offering health benefit plans to provide annual notice to policyholders and certificate holders of specified information about Department of Consumer and Business Services' rate review process and consumer advocacy unit.

SB 470 A

Modifies, for purposes related to prescription monitoring program, definition of "practitioner."

Authorizes State Board of Pharmacy to designate prescription drugs for inclusion in prescription monitoring program.
