**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to maintain list of degrees and certificate programs at institutions of higher education comparing costs and loan default rates for each degree or certificate program.

HB 2621

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Exempts use of pesticides at community college for scientific research or academic instruction from integrated pest management plan restrictions.
