Allows Superintendent of Public Instruction to retain reasonable costs related to investigation and assessment of career school civil penalties.
- HB 2189  
Allows State Board of Education to adopt rules related to general governance and operation of career schools.
- HB 2190  
Requires State Board of Education to adopt minimum standards related to financial soundness of owner of career school.
- HB 2191  
Expands definition of "agent" for career schools.
