- HB 2185 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes adoption of fees for certain activities related to career schools.
- HB 2188 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows Superintendent of Public Instruction to retain reasonable costs related to investigation and assessment of career school civil penalties.
- HB 2189
Allows State Board of Education to adopt rules related to general governance and operation of career schools.
