HB 2958

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires community colleges to annually distribute specified information about community colleges to public school students in grades 11 and 12.

HB 3296

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies, for purposes of regulating student athlete agents, definitions of "agency contract" and "athlete agent." Expands application of statutes regulating athlete agents to include agents representing student athletes at elementary and secondary schools.
