HB 2838 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon Education Investment Board, Oregon University System and Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to propose "Pay Forward, Pay Back" pilot program to replace current system of tuition and fees required to attend institution of higher education.

Public Hearing

HB 2995
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires each public university, community college or other institution of higher education to allow students, faculty and staff to identify sexual orientation on forms used to collect demographic data.

HB 3245
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires inmates participating in apprenticeship program operated by Oregon Corrections Enterprises or Department of Corrections to be under direct supervision of department employee who is licensed or experienced in trade or occupation.

HB 3472 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study on freezing tuition increases for incoming undergraduate students at public universities.

HB 3025 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Next Generation Fund.
