FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for work ready communities programs, employer workforce training and back to work programs.

HB 2152 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires State Board of Higher Education and Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to conduct annual reviews of public universities and community colleges, respectively, regarding staffing to student ratios.

HB 2154

Requires board of education of each community college district to form achievement compact advisory committee.

HB 2178 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides for issuance of education loans to person accepted for enrollment, or to student in good standing, in progra of study for advanced degree necessary to manage medical clinic.

HB 2742

Prohibits public university from discriminating against student on basis that student was not awarded standard high school diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate.

HB 2898

Allows student with disability to earn credit at community college or public university as part of transition services.

HB 2958

Requires community colleges to annually distribute specified information about community colleges to public school students in grades 11 and 12.
