- HB 2152 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/10/13 AGENDA: Requires State Board of Higher Education and Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to conduct annual reviews of public universities and community colleges, respectively, regarding staffing to student ratios.
- HB 2154
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/10/13 AGENDA: Requires board of education of each community college district to form achievement compact advisory committee.
- HB 2742
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/10/13 AGENDA: Prohibits public university from discriminating against student on basis that student was not awarded standard high school diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate.
- HB 2898
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/10/13 AGENDA: Allows student with disability to earn credit at community college or public university as part of transition services.
