- HB 2995
Requires each public university, community college or other institution of higher education to allow students, faculty and staff to identify sexual orientation on forms used to collect demographic data.
- HB 3079
Requires for-profit institutions of higher education to provide students with certain fact sheets regarding costs of education, loans, job placement rates and related data prior to enrollment.
- HB 3149 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Community College Child Care Services.
- HB 3341
Exempts public universities and community colleges from requirement to enter into agreement with for-profit institutions of higher education before implementing potentially duplicative new post-secondary programs.
- HB 3472 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study on freezing tuition increases for incoming undergraduate students at public universities.
- HB 2986
Directs Department of Transportation to work with Department of Corrections, after consultation with Judicial Department, to assist individuals in obtaining driver license after release from Department of Corrections institution

- HB 3115 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits public agencies from entering into public works contracts for which contract price exceeds \$750,000 unless public agency verifies that every employer under contract is approved apprenticeship training agent.
