HB 2674

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires public body to reserve one percent of appropriation for constructing, reconstructing or renovating park or public building for purpose of renovating or improving existing park or public building to meet current accessibility standards for persons with disabilities that are promulgated under Americans with Disabilities Act and regulations adopted pursuant to Act.

HB 2628

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Removes requirement for peace officer, upon discharge of person taken into emergency custody for possible mental illness, to transport person to place where person was taken into custody.
