- HB 2671 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Creates State Office of the Public Guardian and Conservator to provide public guardian and conservator services for persons without relatives or friends willing or able to serve as guardians or conservators.
- HB 3129 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits person from being nominated as fiduciary or serving as fiduciary for three or more protected persons who are not related to person unless person is certified as professional fiduciary by Department of Human Services.
