Work Session

- HB 2316
Exempts pension income from determinations of income and net worth for purposes of qualification to be account holder of individual development account.
- HB 3129 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits person from being nominated as fiduciary or serving as fiduciary for three or more protected persons who are not related to person unless person is certified as professional fiduciary by Department of Human Services.
- HB 2392
Requires membership of Youth Development Council to include representatives of county departments and boards of county commissioners.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3244
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Increases age of runaway and homeless youth for whom Department of Human Services must recommend policies for system of services and support from 18 to 21 years.
- HB 3445 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Department of Human Services to determine whether there are alternative placement options for child or ward in department's custody before committing child or ward to residential care or residential treatment.
- HB 2984 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Appropriates moneys to Department of Education for early childhood development center at Earl Boyles Elementary School.
