HB 2205

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules to ensure that investigations of abuse of vulnerable persons are conducted in uniform, objective and thorough manner throughout state.

HB 2781

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires international matchmaking organization doing business in this state to provide criminal history record information and personal history information about client, and basic rights information, to noncitizen, nonresident recruit.

HB 3032

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Department of Human Services to notify school district, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and Department of Education of report of alleged abuse occurring at school.

HB 3219

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits finding of unfitness, for purpose of terminating parental rights, based solely on emotional illness, mental illness, intellectual or developmental disability or other disability.
