Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2890

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2013 AGENDA: Repeals provision that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.

Work Session

HB 3377

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2013 AGENDA: Limits amount Oregon State Lottery Commission may spend to advertise state lottery.

HB 3131

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2013 AGENDA: Requires superintendent of Oregon State Hospital to establish and implement program for continuous employment of health care professionals who provide specified services.

HB 3482

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2013 AGENDA: Makes residential landlord responsible for maintenance of hazard trees on rented space for manufactured dwelling.

HB 2392

Requires membership of Youth Development Council to include representatives of county departments and boards of county commissioners.

HB 3445

Requires Department of Human Services to determine whether there are alternative placement options for child or ward in department's custody before committing child or ward to residential care or residential treatment.

HB 3007

Requires owner of residential facility to offer tenants opportunity to purchase facility before owner offers to sell facility to third party.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2013

Directs Early Learning Council and Department of Education to assist school districts in implementing process to assess children to determine their readiness for kindergarten.
