HB 2547

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies statutes relating to jurors summoned by circuit courts.

HB 2562

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.

HB 2565

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Gives judgment lien awarded to custodian of law practice priority over certain other creditors and security interests.

HB 2570

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Clarifies that funds of protected person may be used to pay reasonable compensation rendered on behalf of respondent in protective proceeding.
