Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2049

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes juvenile community supervision officer to take youth offender who violates parole into custody upon issuance of order or warrant of arrest.

HB 2395

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes Task Force on Human Trafficking to conduct study and make recommendations for legislation addressing issues related to human trafficking in Oregon.

HB 2433

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Prohibits court from considering party's disability in judgment awarding child custody unless clear and convincing evidence shows awarding custody of child to party with disability is not in child's best interests and welfare.
