Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2375
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to extend period of time between parole hearings based on majority vote.
- HB 2378
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows parent or guardian of minor to file petition seeking appointment of guardian for minor as adult within 90 days before minor attains majority or such other time as court deems necessary and appropriate.
- HB 2563 **
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies annual salaries of justices of Supreme Court and judges of Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2559
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies law regarding establishment and modification of spousal support in domestic relations proceedings.
- HB 2571
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Clarifies that spousal support payments terminate on death of either party in domestic relations proceeding.
- HB 2572
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows court to order payment of attorney fees, costs and expenses in domestic relations proceeding that relates to life insurance.
