Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2573

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that practicing law in this state without active Oregon State Bar membership is unlawful practice subject to enforcement under Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

HB 2226

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Prohibits court hearing change of name application from requiring notice of application and judgment if applicant is participant in Address Confidentiality Program, unless good cause exists.

Work Session

HB 2562

Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.
