FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides exception for citizens of certain countries to have driver license or identification card for eight years even if length of stay in United States is unknown.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases fee paid to certain agencies and organizations for diagnostic assessment required for possession of marijuana diversion agreement.

HB 2115

Expands offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants to include any drug that adversely affects person's physical or mental faculties to noticeable or perceptible degree.

HB 2116

Authorizes court to provide medical exemption to person otherwise required to install ignition interlock device as pa of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement if person meets requirements established by Department of Transportation by rule.

HB 2117

Extends suspension of driving privileges beyond end of suspension or revocation period if person fails to submit proof of installation or maintain installation of required ignition interlock device.

HB 2121

Authorizes court to issue notice to Department of Transportation if defendant is convicted of driving under influenc of intoxicants and fails to comply with court-ordered treatment.
