Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2450

Makes certain persons providing outreach services to individuals who are under supervision of corrections officer immune from civil liability.

HB 2519

Modifies provisions limiting liability of health clinics, volunteer health practitioners and volunteers providing outreach services to homeless individuals.

SB 27

Modifies dates by which certain governmental entities must submit asset forfeiture reports.

Work Session

HB 2570

Clarifies that funds of protected person may be used to pay reasonable compensation rendered on behalf of respondent in protective proceeding.
