HB 2235 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Eliminates sunset of provision requiring Department of Corrections to provide training for basic certification of corrections officers employed by department.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2563 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies annual salaries of justices of Supreme Court and judges of Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts.

HB 2234
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Eliminates sunset of provision authorizing supervisory authority to place offenders or inactive post-prison supervision.

HB 2596
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides private entity contracting with State Forestry Department for performance of forest practice on state forestland with cause of action against person intentionally committing act hindering, impairing, obstructing or attempting to hinder, impair or obstruct private entity performance of forest practice.

HB 2603
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that device seized by law enforcement agency as gray machine must be returned if prosecution for crime of possession of gray machine is not commenced within six months after seizure.

HB 2605
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Modifies certain law enforcement defenses applicable to certain firearms-related crimes.

HB 2685
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes temporary release of inmates conveyed to another jurisdiction on same terms as inmates confined in Department of Corrections institution.
