Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2775

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Changes standard of conduct under which person may be liable for unlawful practice under Unlawful Trade Practices Act from willful conduct to knowing conduct.

HB 2776

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Changes circumstances under which prosecuting attorney may execute and serve investigative demand related to alleged unlawful act or practice.

HB 2777

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Permits defendant in action under unlawful trade practices law or unlawful debt collections law to respond to action with affirmative defense in which defendant shows by preponderance of evidence that defendant did not intend violation and that violation resulted from bona fide error notwithstanding defendant's maintenance of procedures reasonably adapted to avoid violation.

SB 50

Provides that trial court has jurisdiction to enter appealable order after filing of notice of appeal in certain circumstances.

Work Session

HB 2552

Eliminates obligation to report as sex offender if person is required to report solely as result of juvenile court adjudication for act committed when person was under 16 years of age.
