Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2544
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes prosecuting attorney to waive prohibition on expunging traffic violations.
- HB 3176
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Shortens time person must wait before petitioning court or applying to Department of Transportation to restore revoked driving privileges.

Work Session

- HB 2115
Expands offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants to include any drug that adversely affects person's physical or mental faculties to noticeable or perceptible degree.
- HB 2116
Authorizes court to provide medical exemption to person otherwise required to install ignition interlock device as part of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement if person meets requirements established by Department of Transportation by rule.
- HB 2125
Requires person to pay restitution as requirement of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement.
- HB 2627
Permits court to vacate judgment after termination of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement under certain conditions.
